Day 1: Benvenuti in Calabria!

Arrive at Lamezia Terme Airport. Transfer to **Villa Fabiano**, your boutique hotel a few short miles from Cosenza, an almost undiscovered medieval town located in northern Calabria. After settling into your room, you are free to enjoy the pool, spa** or simply relax in your comfortable room with its large balcony. That evening, you'll meet the group for a welcome dinner in the hotel's dining room, complete with local Calabrian wines. All courses will be cooked by one of the most important chefs of the **Calabria Cooking Academy**. Overnight in Rende.

Day 2: Caciocavallo, Cirò Winery and Santa Severina Castello




After breakfast, you will discover Calabria's most famous Caciocavallo Silano DOP at a local family-run dairy for a tour and tasting. Then, you'll have the opportunity to prepare your very own Caciocavallo and Mozzarella with expert guidance from the professional cheesemakers. We then head south to the highly acclaimed Cirò wine region of the Crotone province. Cirò wine is nicknamed the Barolo of the South and is known as Calabria's best wine. Lunch will be at a local restaurant serving specialties of Crotone. After, we head to the picturesque mountaintop village of Santa Severina for a tour of its stunningly beautiful Castello and medieval village. There you'll learn about its importance for Byzantine art and history. In the evening, you'll enjoy an Italian Aperitivi & Bibita al Caffè (a unique Calabrian drink) in the hotel's restaurant. Overnight in Rende.

Day 3: Village of Altomonte & Cooking Class at Hotel Barbieri



This morning you can sleep in, schedule a spa treatment** or enjoy the amenities of the hotel. Later this morning, we will head to charming **Altomonte**. You will explore the old town before attending a fun interactive cooking class held by a talented chef of the **Hotel Barbieri** family. Your hands-on class will include *gnocchi, eggplant polpette, braciole, peperoni cruschi (crunchy peppers),* and a few other surprises. You may participate or simply sit and watch as dishes are demonstrated. You'll have dinner at the Barbieri restaurant, and enjoy a selection of wines and beverages to accompany your meal. Overnight in Rende.

and other attractions. This afternoon, you'll learn how to make traditional **Pizza Calabrese** and enjoy it for dinner. You'll visit **Pasticceria Renzelli**, one of the best pastry shops in the city. Here you can feast your eyes on their beautiful delicacies, and taste your favorites. After, you will have some free time to stroll the lovely walking promenade of Corso Mazzini and view its open air museum with the sculptures of famous artists such as **Salvador Dali and Giorgio Chirico.** Overnight in Rende.

Day 5: Tropea Boat Trip ("Coast of The Gods") & Pizzo, Tartufo Ice Cream Experience



This morning, you'll head south on the **Tyrrhenian Coast** to the beautiful seaside town of Tropea for a scenic boat ride along the dramatic Calabrian coastline, known as "Costa degli Dei" (Coast of the Gods), including a light aperitivo onboard. After, you will visit the Sanctuario di Santa Maria dell 'Isola, and the famous balcony viewpoint of Tropea. We will leave in the afternoon to visit Italy's most famous gelato shops in the main square of **Pizzo**, where **tartufo** ice **cream** was invented. This town is a mecca for ice cream fans from around the world! You will be given an exclusive tartufo demonstration by the man whose father created this world-famous treat. Then, relax and enjoy your favorite flavor. After, you'll be free time to roam around the historic center of Pizzo, before returning to the hotel for a free evening. Overnight in Rende.

Day 6: Maccaroni Chef Academy Paola, Shrine of San Francesco



Today, we will learn to make several traditional Calabrese dishes at the trendy, ultra-modern cooking studio of the "Maccaroni Chef Academy" in Cosenza. Afterward, you'll visit the quaint village of Paola with its ancient alleys, old churches, and breathtaking panoramic views. This is the birthplace of San Francesco. Here, we will visit the Shrine of St. Francis of Paola and have a guided tour. Tonight, you'll have an elegant dinner at Palazzo Salfi, a charming upscale restaurant in the illuminated old town of Cosenza.

Day 7: Rossano, Codex, and Byzantine Culture

This morning, you'll head north on the **Ionian Sea** for a guided tour of the famous **Amarelli licorice museum**. Here, you will learn about the long history of licorice production in Calabria, its medicinal qualities and, of course, the many sweets that are made from it. You'll get to taste candies, gelatos and coffee all made with licorice. (*Continued*)





Day 7: Rossano, Codex, and Byzantine Culture (Continued)

Then, we head to the enchanting historical center of Rossano where you'll visit one of Calabria's most stunning churches. A few steps away, you will enter the Codex museum to see the astonishingly well-preserved Codex Purpureus (the ancient illustrated Gospels of Saints Matthew and Mark). Afterwards, you'll have a break to enjoy some light snacks at a stylish art caffè. Then we will visit the elegant Castello di Corigliano. After, you'll return back to the hotel for a rest and to organize your suitcases for our hotel change the next day. This evening, you'll have an enjoyable cooking class with the hotel's highly awarded master chef. You will learn how to make two traditional Calabrese pastas: Ravioli with 'Nduja and Lagane e Ceci. Dinner at the Hotel's restaurant. Overnight in Rende.

Day 8: Cooking Class and Wine Tour on the Sant'Eufemia's Bay



MIDNIGHT SPECIAL: Your farewell dinner will consists of *Spaghettata aglio, olio e pepperoncino,* and a **spectacular Calabrian-style FIREWORKS display with music and dance.** Overnight at Agriturismo.

Day 9: Departure / Transfer

You'll have breakfast at the Agriturismo, then depart to Lamezia Terme Airport to return home.

Note: Arrive home same day.
